

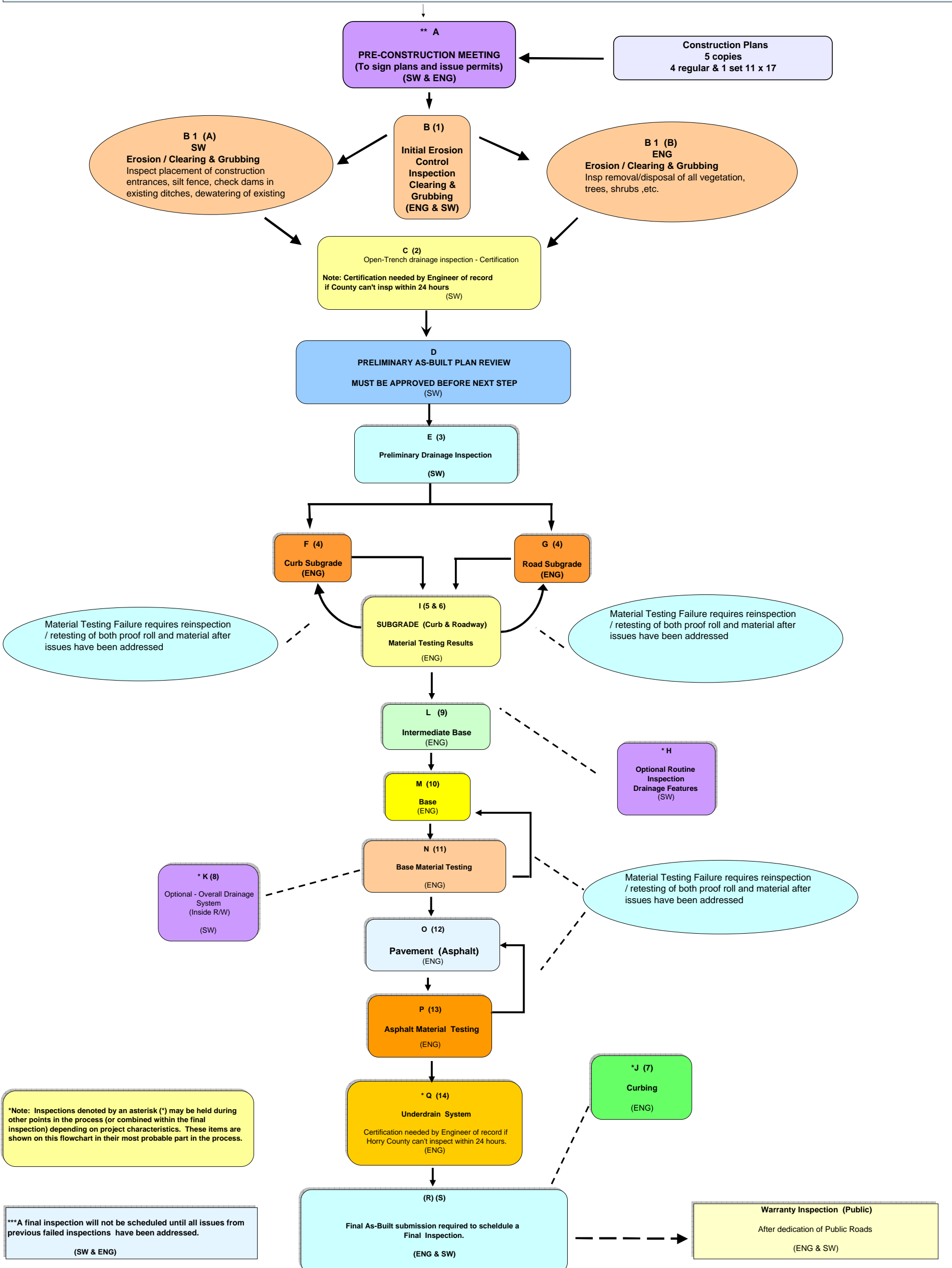
# Horry County Engineering And Stormwater Inspection Flow Chart For Major Developments With Plans "Approvable" by July 1, 2008

**\*\* Preconstruction meeting process.**

1. Preliminary plans must be marked as "approvable" by all applicable Horry County Departments.
2. Upon receipt of an "approvable" preliminary plan notification from the Planning Department, the Engineer of record will request a pre-construction meeting by contacting the Horry County Engineering department with available dates and times for the meeting (contact number is 843-915-6936.)
3. The Horry County Engineering Department will then determine the date and time of the preconstruction meeting (required attendees include Horry County Engineering & Stormwater Departments, Engineer of record, and Contractor; the Developer should attend if available).
4. The engineer of record is responsible for bringing construction plans to meeting. **(5 copies - 4 full size & 1 set 11 x 17)**

**NOTE:** All content within the hard copies of the construction plans shall not be modified from the version marked as "approvable" by all applicable Horry County Departments. If the plans need to be modified, the engineer of record shall resubmit preliminary plans to the planning department with a brief summary of changes. If the preconstruction meeting was scheduled, it will be postponed until the revised plans are marked as "approvable" by the appropriate Horry County Departments.

5. Construction cannot proceed until after the conclusion of the pre-construction meeting (all construction plans signed and permits received.)



\*Note: Inspections denoted by an asterisk (\*) may be held during other points in the process (or combined within the final inspection) depending on project characteristics. These items are shown on this flowchart in their most probable part in the process.

\*\*\*A final inspection will not be scheduled until all issues from previous failed inspections have been addressed.
