AN ORDINANCE TO PROHIBIT THE OBSTRUCTION OF DRAINAGE AND/OR RIGHTS-OF-WAYS

WHEREAS, the Horry County Council deems it necessary in order to prohibit the obstruction of drainage and/or rights-of-way and to ensure that critical drainage is maintained for the common good does hereby adopt that:

1. No person shall block or allow to be blocked, permanently or temporarily, any drainage ditch, system or appurtenance thereto for the purpose of crossing said drainage facility for access to adjacent property, or for any other reason.

2. No person shall store or deposit materials of any type on a public right-of-way or easement in such a manner as to hamper or impede the flow of water within said right-of-way or easement or to restrict the movement or endanger the traveling public. Easement for maintenance of drainage systems shall also be kept open and shall not be fenced nor have any structure or permanent plantings which shall deny access for the intended purpose.

3. Any person who violates the provisions of this section shall be liable for any damages occurring to the drainage system, roadway, pavement, or appurtenances as a result of this action upon conviction.

4. Any person who violates the provisions of this section shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction shall be punished by a fine of not exceeding two hundred dollars (\$200) or by imprisonment not to exceed thirty (30) days in the discretion of the Court. Each day this section is violated shall constitute a separate offense.

This Ordinance shall take effect upon its third reading.
