♦ *Hog Inlet-Cherry Grove Microbial Source Tracking Study – Dr. Erin Burge and Dr. Susan Libes* – Dr. Burge and Dr. Libes gave a power point presentation on work that was recently done in partnership with the City of North Myrtle Beach. No human fecal bacterial was found. Sea Mountain Highway and Jack’s Circle Rd are consistent issues of concern which suggests that additional stormwater best management practices need to be investigated.

♦ *Inovative Stormwater Practices in Murrells Inlet Watershed.* – Dave Fuss gave a power point presentation about the recent installation of floating wetlands at the pond on Woodland Drive in Garden City as part of the 319 grant from SC DHEC to implement the Murrells Inlet Watershed Plan
